

DECEMBER 18, 2022 THE SUFFERING SAVIOR ISAIAH 52:13-53:12

Big Idea: Jesus died for our sins because Jesus loves sinful people!

A: The Servant's Success: Repulsive but Redemptive (52:13-15)

B: The Servant's Suffering: Lived in Rejection (53:1-3)

C: The Servant's Significance: Our Sin Bearer (53:4-6)

B: The Servant's Suffering: Died in Innocence (53:7-9)

A: The Servant's Success: Crushed, but Victorious (53:10-12)

Reflection Questions:

- 1. Do you struggle to believe that you are forgiven? How does Isaiah's Servant Song help you believe you really are?
- 2. Is anything causing you to be hesitant to hand your sin over to Jesus and accept His forgiveness? Tell Jesus about that and ask Him to help you take that step of faith.
- 3. Write a prayer of gratitude to Jesus for forgiving you and taking away the weight of sin from you.
