Big Idea: Advent invites us to believe that all of God's promises will come true in Jesus.

Reflection Questions:

1. *What promises of God have you been holding on to recently? What is it you are waiting on Him to do?*
2. *How are you experiencing it when God's answer to your prayer seems delayed? Where are you experiencing despair about God's promises?*
3. *Consider Ephesians 3:20:*

*"Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine,
according to his power that is at work within us..."*

How does this encourage you? Is there any way in which you sense God inviting you to see that His plans are much bigger than yours? That His love is much broader than what you want from Him? Is there any way in which He is inviting you to trust that He will do more than you could even imagine?
